Day 00

Departure from Delhi – The Journey Begins

Board your overnight Volvo from Delhi to Manali.

The excitement quietly builds as you leave the chaos of everyday life and head towards the mountains—where everything feels slower, calmer, and more real.



Day 01

Arrival in Manali– A Gentle Start

Wake up to crisp mountain air as you arrive in Manali.

After checking into your hotel, take the day at your own pace. Walk along **Mall Road**, sip something warm, and prepare yourself for the adventure ahead.

This is your moment to pause—because from tomorrow, the journey gets intense, beautiful, and unforgettable.

❄️ Day 02

Manali to Sarchu– Into the High Himalayas

Today, you leave comfort behind and step into raw Himalayan terrain.

Drive through the engineering marvel of the **Atal Tunnel**, emerging into landscapes that feel dramatically different. Continue across **Baralacha La Pass**, where snow-capped peaks and vast barren stretches surround you.

The journey to **Sarchu** is long, but every turn offers views that make it worthwhile.

❄️ Day 03

Sarchu to Leh—Roads That Test and Reward

This is one of the most thrilling drives of your trip.

Navigate the iconic **Gata Loops**, a series of sharp bends that wind through the mountains.

Cross Lachung La and Tanglang La Pass, where the altitude reminds you just how high you've come.

By the time you reach Leh, you've already lived an experience many only dream of.

❄️ Day 04

Leh to Nubra Valley via Khardung La

The adventure continues as you ride/drive over **Khardung La Pass**, one of the highest motorable roads in the world.

As you descend into **Nubra Valley**, the landscape transforms into a cold desert —vast, open, and strikingly beautiful.

Visit **Diskit Monastery**, overlooking the valley, and explore the unique **Hunder Sand Dunes**, where double-humped camels roam against a surreal backdrop.

❄️ Day 05

Nubra to Pangong– The Scenic Transition

Today's route via the **Shyok Valley** is one of Ladakh's hidden gems.

The road hugs rivers, cuts through mountains, and constantly surprises you with changing landscapes.

And then, you arrive at **Pangong Lake**—a vast stretch of water that reflects the sky in shades of blue you didn't know existed. It's quiet, powerful, and humbling.

Overnight stay: Nubra Valley

Day 06

Pangong to Koyul– Into the Remote Frontier

Today, the journey takes you beyond the usual Ladakh routes.

Drive through **Chushul village**, a place steeped in history, and visit the **Rezang La War Memorial**, a powerful reminder of bravery and sacrifice.

Continue towards Koyul/Hanle, where the landscape becomes more remote, more silent, and incredibly raw.

Overnight stay: Koyul / Hanle

Day 07

UmlingLa– The Ultimate Achievement

This is the day that defines the entire expedition.

Ride/drive to **Umling La Pass**, the highest motorable road in the world. At this altitude, everything feels surreal—the air, the silence, the sense of accomplishment.

Continue to **Demchok**, the last village near the Indo–China border, where the land feels untouched and almost otherworldly.

Return by evening, carrying a story that very few people get to tell.

Overnight stay: Koyul / Hanle

Day 08

Koyulto Tso Moriri– Serenity After Adventure

After days of rugged terrain, today brings a softer, more serene experience.

Drive through the geothermal landscapes of **Puga Valley**, where steam rises from the earth, creating a unique visual contrast.

Arrive at **Tso Moriri Lake**, a quieter, less crowded alternative to Pangong –calm, vast, and deeply peaceful.

Overnight stay: Korzok (Tso Moriri)

❄️ Day 09

Tso Moriri to Sarchu – One Last Ride

Begin your return journey via **Tso Kar Lake**, known for its stark beauty and open landscapes.

As you ride back to Sarchu, there's a quiet realization—this journey is coming to an end, but the experience will stay with you long after.

Overnight stay: Sarchu

Day 10

Sarchu to Manali— Back to Civilization

Drive back to Manali, retracing your path through the mountains.

By evening, board your overnight Volvo to Delhi—leaving behind the Himalayas, but carrying their silence within you.

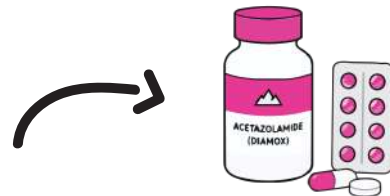

Inclusions



- Delhi–Manali–Delhi Volvo transfers (AC)
- Manali–Sarchu–Leh–Ladakh circuit travel (Tempo Traveller / Cab)
- Bike rental (Day 2 to Day 10) for riders
- Fuel included for entire biking route
- 9 nights accommodation (hotels, camps, cottages)
- 18 meals (Daily Breakfast & Dinner, except breakfast on day 1 and dinner on day 10)
- Riding gear: helmet, **jacket**, knee guards
- Experienced Trip Captain & road leader
- Mechanical backup with support vehicle
- Spare wheels for emergencies
- Inner Line Permits for all restricted areas
- Toll taxes, parking & driver charges
- First aid kit & oxygen cylinder (24x7 support)



Exclusions

- 5% GST
- Lunch, snacks, beverages (alcohol, soft drinks, etc.)
- Entry tickets & camera charges
- Personal expenses (laundry, calls, tips, etc.)
- Travel insurance
- Security deposit for bike (₹5,000 refundable)
- Room service / additional hotel expenses
- Costs due to landslides, weather, delays
- Any extra services not mentioned in inclusions



Important Notes for Travelers :

- This is a high-altitude expedition with long travel hours
- Proper acclimatisation and hydration are essential
- Carry valid ID proof for permits
- Network connectivity is limited in remote areas
- Weather & terrain may require itinerary flexibility
- For biking option the bikers will have to drive 150–250km daily.
