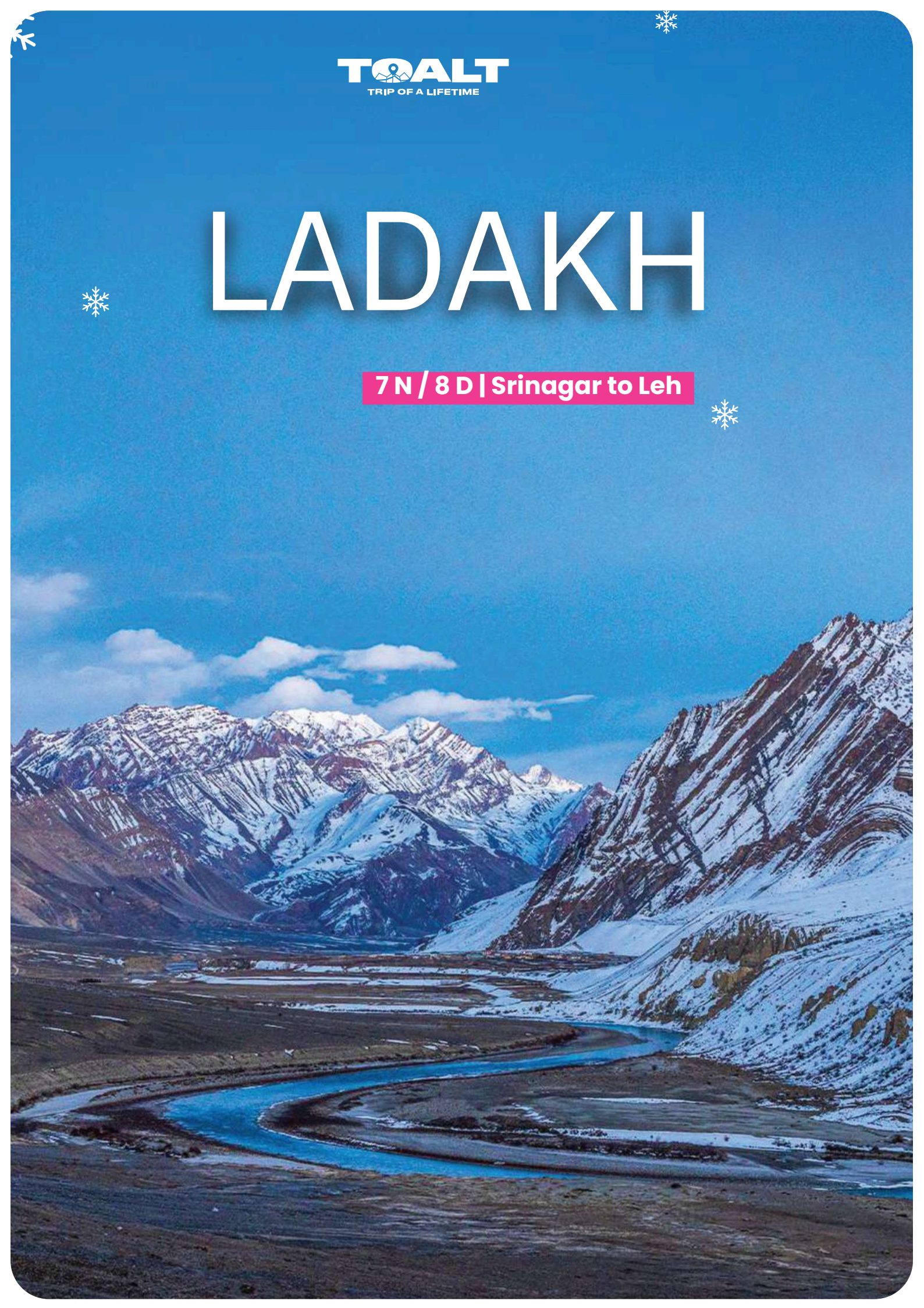

Day 01

Arrival in Srinagar – A Serene Beginning

Your journey begins in the beautiful valley of Srinagar, where time seems to slow down. Upon arrival, check into a traditional houseboat—your stay for the night, floating gently on the calm waters.

Spend your day exploring the iconic Dal Lake, visiting the peaceful Shankaracharya Temple, and strolling through the elegant Mughal Gardens, known for their symmetry and charm.

It's a soft, scenic start—before the mountains begin to rise higher.

Overnight stay: Houseboat (Srinagar)

❄️ Day 02

Srinagar to Kargil– From Valleys to High Passes

Leave behind the greenery of Kashmir as you drive towards Ladakh.

Pass through the breathtaking meadows of **Sonamarg**, and then cross the thrilling **Zoji La Pass**, where the landscape dramatically changes from lush to rugged.

En route, visit the **Drass War Memorial**, a place that quietly tells stories of courage and sacrifice.

By evening, reach **Kargil**—marking your entry into a more rugged Himalayan terrain.

❄️ Day 03

Kargil to Leh—Landscapes That Keep Changing

Today's journey is filled with constant visual surprises.

Drive through the surreal terrain of Lamayuru, often called “Moonland” for its unique formations. Continue towards **Magnetic Hill, Pathar Sahib Gurudwara, and the striking Indus–Zaskar Sangam.**

Every stop adds a new layer to your Ladakh experience—spiritual, scenic, and unforgettable.

Arrive in Leh by evening.

❄️ Day 04

Leh to Nubra Valley—Desert in the Mountains

Spend your day exploring the beauty of Nubra Valley.

Cross the legendary **Khardung La Pass**, one of the highest motorable roads in the world, and descend into the stunning **Nubra Valley**.

Visit **Diskit Monastery**, overlooking the valley, and then head to the surreal **Hunder Sand Dunes**—where double-humped camels walk across a cold desert framed by snow-capped peaks.

It's a contrast you won't find anywhere else.

❄️ Day 05

Nubra to Turtuk—Into the Borderlands

Today, your journey takes you deeper into the mountains.

continue towards **Turtuk Village**, a unique destination near the Indo-Pak border.

The culture here feels different—rich in Balti heritage and stories.

Overnight stay: Nubra / Hunder

❄️ Day 06

Nubra to Pangong– A Drive You Won't Forget

Today's journey is one of Ladakh's most scenic experiences.

Travel via the **Agham–Shyok route**, a road that winds along rivers and through untouched terrain.

And then, you arrive at Pangong Lake—a vast expanse of water that shifts shades with the light, from deep blue to turquoise.

It's quiet, powerful, and deeply calming.

Overnight stay: Pangong (camp/cottage)

Day 07

Pangong to Leh—Through Monasteries & Mountains

Wake up to a peaceful sunrise by the lake before beginning your return journey.

Drive via **Chang La Pass**, and en route visit:

Shey Palace, known for its royal past

Thiksey Monastery, with its striking architecture

Hemis Monastery, one of the richest monasteries in Ladakh

By evening, you return to Leh—carrying experiences that go far beyond a typical trip.

Overnight stay: Leh

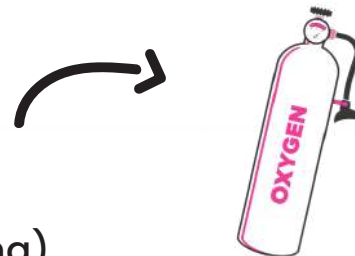

Inclusions

- Royal Enfield Himalayan 411 (BS6) for biking option
- Fuel for entire journey (as per itinerary)
- Riding gear: helmet*, jacket, knee & elbow guards
- Experienced Trip Captain, Marshal & Mechanic
- Backup vehicle for luggage & support
- Inner Line Permits
- Wildlife & environmental fees
- Sightseeing as per itinerary
- Oxygen cylinder & first aid support
- Airport pickup/drop (fixed group timing)
