Day 00

Departure from Delhi – The Journey Begins

Board your overnight Volvo from Delhi to Manali.

□ Day 01

Arrival in Manali – A Gentle Start

A Gentle Start Wake up to crisp mountain air as you arrive in Manali. After checking into your hotel, take the day at your own pace. Walk along Mall Road, sip something warm, and prepare yourself for the adventure ahead. This is your moment to pause—because from tomorrow, the journey gets intense, beautiful, and unforgettable.

Day 02

Manali to Sarchu/Jispa – Into the High Himalayas

Drive through the engineering marvel of the **Atal Tunnel**, emerging into landscapes that feel dramatically different. Continue across **Baralacha La Pass**, where snow-capped peaks and vast barren stretches surround you.

The journey to **Sarchu** is long, but every turn offers views that make it worthwhile.

Navigate the iconic **Gata Loops**, a series of sharp bends that wind through the mountains.

By the time you reach Leh, you've already lived an experience many only dream of.

❄️ Day 04

Exploring Leh – Where Culture Meets Landscape

After breakfast, your journey truly begins. Drive through the fascinating Magnetic Hill, where reality seems to bend. Stop at Pathar Sahib Gurudwara, a place of deep spiritual calm. Witness the powerful meeting of rivers at the Indus–Zaskar Sangam. As the day unfolds, you'll visit the iconic Shanti Stupa, offering panoramic views of Leh, and the historic Leh Palace, standing tall with stories of the past. End your day walking through Leh Market—colorful, lively, and full of local charm.

❄️ Day 05

Leh → Nubra Valley via Khardung La

The adventure continues as you ride/drive over Khardung La Pass, one of the highest motorable roads in the world. As you descend into Nubra Valley, the landscape transforms into a cold desert — vast, open, and strikingly beautiful. Visit Diskit Monastery, overlooking the valley, and explore the unique Hunder Sand Dunes, where double-humped camels roam against a surreal backdrop

❄️ Day 06

Nubra to Pangong– The Scenic Transition

Today's route via the **Shyok Valley** is one of Ladakh's hidden gems.

The road hugs rivers, cuts through mountains, and constantly surprises you with changing landscapes.

And then, you arrive at **Pangong Lake**—a vast stretch of water that reflects the sky in shades of blue you didn't know existed. It's quiet, powerful, and humbling.

❄️ Day 07

Journey from Pangong to hanle with rezangla war memorial

Today, the journey takes you beyond the usual Ladakh routes.

Drive through **Chushul village**, a place steeped in history, and visit the **Rezang La War Memorial**, a powerful reminder of bravery and sacrifice.

Continue towards Koyul/Hanle, where the landscape becomes more remote, more silent, and incredibly raw.

Day 08

UmlingLa, Demchok and transfer to tso moriri – The Ultimate Achievement

This is the day that defines the entire expedition.

Ride/drive to **Umling La Pass**, the highest motorable road in the world. At this altitude, everything feels surreal—the air, the silence, the sense of accomplishment.

Continue to **Demchok**, the last village near the Indo-China border, where the land feels untouched and almost otherworldly.

Return by evening to Tso moriri, carrying a story that very few people get to tell.

Tso Moriri to sarchu - Serenity After Adventure

Begin your return journey via Tso Kar Lake, known for its stark beauty and open landscapes. As you ride back to Sarchu, there's a quiet realization—

this journey is coming to an end, but the experience will stay with you long after.

❄️ Day 10

Sarchu → Manali – Back to Civilization

- Post breakfast in the morning, get ready for the day.
- Today, we will board our transfers to Manali via Atal Tunnel.
- On the way, we will take a quick stop at the iconic Baralacha La located at an altitude of 4850m.
- Then, we will pass the scenic Suraj Taal and Deepak Taal Lakes.
- Further, we will pass the picturesque towns of Darcha, Jispa, Keylong and Sissu until we reach the Atal Tunnel.
- After crossing the Atal Tunnel, pass through the Solang Valley – a hub for adventure activities to reach Manali.
- Upon reaching Manali, check in to your hotel and spend the evening at leisure.
- You can either rest in your room or head out to explore the Mall road where you can shop, eat or take a stroll.

Journey from manali to delhi

Wake up to a leisurely morning in Manali and have your breakfast at the hotel. You can then spend the day at leisure exploring Manali's charming attractions on your own. You can start your sightseeing by visiting the famous Hidimba Temple, dedicated to the wife of Bheem. Further, you can relax in the natural hot springs of Vashisht Temple which is dedicated to sage Vashisht, teacher of Lord Ram. After exploring various attractions, you can shop and eat around the famous Mall Road. By evening, reach the Manali bus stop to board your bus to Delhi. Overnight bus journey to Delhi.

Important Notes for Travelers :

- This is a high-altitude expedition with long travel hours
- Proper acclimatisation and hydration are essential
- Carry valid ID proof for permits
- Network connectivity is limited in remote areas
- Weather & terrain may require itinerary flexibility
- For biking option the bikers will have to drive 150-250km daily.

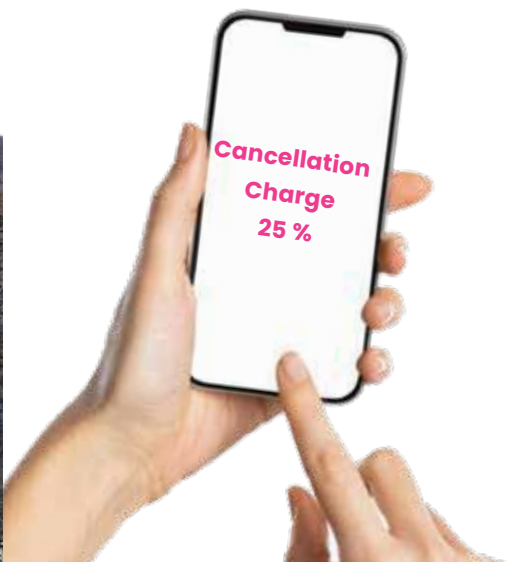
